

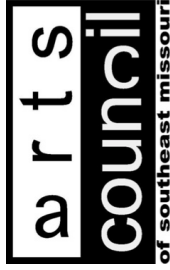

Juror

Professor Caroline Kahler joined the Southeast Missouri State University Art Faculty as Chair in the Fall semester of 2011. She has an MFA degree from Wichita State University, KS in ceramics, her MA degree in fibers from Purdue University and her BS degree from Kutztown State College in art education.

Kahler came to Missouri from Bethany College in Lindsborg, Kansas. During her 20 years in Kansas she served as chair of the Bethany College Art Department; a juror on numerous occasions for the Salina Arts and Humanities Commission and the Salina River Festival; as Art Education Program Reviewer for the Kansas State Department of Education; and Juror for the Kansas Governor's Art Award.

Kahler's artwork has been displayed regionally, and nationally, and images of her work have been shown internationally. Her exhibited artwork shows a wide range of interests and variety, demonstrating her skills in jewelry construction, the art of the book, off loom fiber arts and organic ceramic pieces. Her work can be found in numerous personal and museum collections. Kahler is an active exhibiting member of the Circle of 7 Artists.

Awards

Cash awards will be given for Best of Show and four Juror's Awards to be designated by the Juror, whose decision is final. Awards will be distributed at the exhibition opening reception Sunday, June 29, 2-4 pm, in the Outpatient Surgical Corridor at Southeast Hospital. The awards are sponsored by the Cape Girardeau County Area Medical Society Alliance, the Cape Girardeau County Area Medical Society, and SoutheastHEALTH.

Sales and Commissions

Every effort is made to promote sales. The Arts Council of Southeast Missouri will retain a 30% commission.

Art for the Health of It 2014

Statement of Purpose

Art for the Health of It provides a way to utilize art as a calming agent in a stress-laden environment, while demonstrating the health and healing benefits of artistic images and expression. The exhibit will be displayed in the surgical waiting room corridor at Southeast Hospital.

Eligibility

Open to all area artists 18 years and older living within a 175-mile radius of Cape Girardeau. Entries must be original, two-dimensional works in any medium, not previously exhibited at Southeast Hospital, or created in a workshop or class. Maximum size 48" x 48", including frame. Maximum weight: 75 lbs. Works must be framed and wired for installation. NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS. Nudes and unframed works will not be exhibited. The Juror reserves the right to disqualify any work not suitably presented, or that varies from the submitted image. Accepted works of art will remain on exhibit during the duration of the event unless otherwise allowed by the event Director. This is for both sold and unsold works during the event.

Entry Fees

The non-refundable entry fee is \$25 for up to three works (Arts Council Members pay \$20) and \$5.00 for each additional entry after that. There is no maximum number of entries, but no more than three works by any artist will be exhibited. Diptychs and triptychs will be considered as two or three entries.

Entry Procedure

Entries will be accepted in the form of a JPEG image on a CD. High resolution images are preferred. **Required: 1 image per each 2-D piece, 2 images per 3-D piece.** We suggest 300 dpi at 4" x 6". Please label each image file with the artist's name and entry number (smith01, smith02, etc.). Also include title, medium, size (indicated as height first, length second). On the CD, please include artist's name, address, phone number and email. A stamped, self-addressed envelope must be provided with the CD. Declined entries will be returned with notification, accepted disks will be held for comparison by the juror.

Please Include: Entry Fee (payable to Arts Council), completed entry form, CD, and self-addressed and stamped return envelope.

Shipment and Delivery

Shipping artwork to and from the exhibit is the responsibility of the artist. Artist may use his/her own shipping company preference, and is responsible for scheduling delivery and pick-up of artwork. Works must be labeled with artist's name, title of work, media, and price. **Shipping cartons must be reusable and within shipping guidelines.** Please use professional grade boxes. No packing peanuts allowed. Late or damaged work will not be exhibited. Hand deliveries will be accepted during normal gallery hours, 10 am to 4 pm, from Saturday, February 16 through Wednesday, February 20.

Return of Work

Exhibited, hand-delivered work **MUST** be picked up at the close of the exhibit, Thursday, August 28, between **9 am and 12 PM in the Outpatient Surgical Corridor.** If you are not able to pick up your pieces on this day, the Arts Council will hold your pieces until Sept. 3, 2014. Shipped works will be crated and ready for shipment by Sept. 3. **It is the responsibility of the artist to provide postage and insurance to and from the exhibit and to schedule delivery and pick-up of the work.**

Liability

Receipt of the completed form constitutes your agreement with all conditions established in the prospectus. It is the responsibility of the artist to provide all shipping costs and insurance on works during shipment. Consent to reproduce works photographically, for publicity purposes, is assumed to be granted.

All reasonable care will be taken with your works, but the Arts Council of Southeast Missouri will not be responsible for theft or damage incurred at the location. We recommend artists provide their own insurance coverage for each submission.
