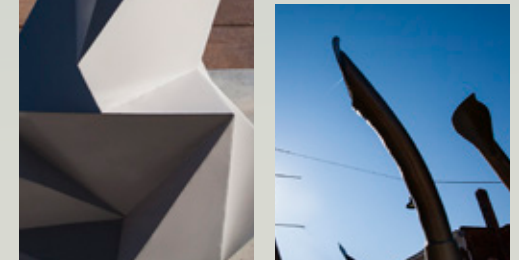
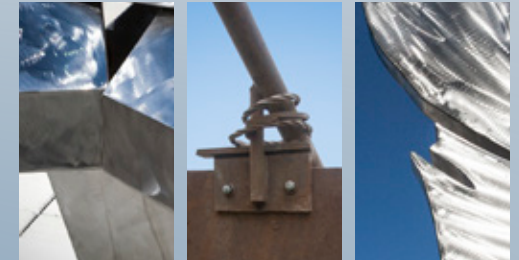

Juror's Statement

"The artists included in this exhibition represent a cross section of contemporary sculpture. From the formal abstraction of Beth Nybeck, to the interwoven narratives of Chris Wubbena and the whimsical constructions of Dan Perry, my intent was to seek works that would best encourage a wide range of interpretations and dialog for this inaugural exhibition. Nybeck, working primarily with metal, uses public spaces as platforms for showcasing nature-inspired abstract works. Nybeck's work has been exhibited in more than 10 states, including a permanent installation in the John Wayne International Airport in Orange County, CA, a series of sculptures for the Playable Sculpture Park in Sandy Springs, GA, and a sculpture for Newark, NJ. She graduated from the University of Northern Iowa with a BFA in Sculpture.

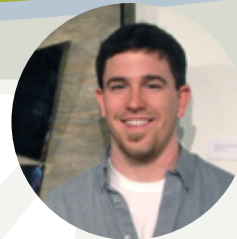

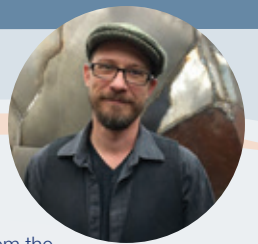

Chris Wubbena holds a B.F.A. from the University of Northern Iowa, an M.F.A. with an emphasis in Sculpture from San Francisco State University, and is currently a professional sculptor and Associate Professor of Art at Southeast Missouri State University. His work has been exhibited in outdoor and indoor exhibitions throughout the United States. In addition, Wubbena has been awarded various grants for the completion of larger indoor installation projects, including a Mississippi Arts Commission Visual Arts Fellowship with funding from the National Endowment for the Arts for the completion on Wubbena's de minimis series, and, most recently, a Grants and Research Funding Committee Grant from Southeast Missouri State University to complete a project titled speaking while listening, which is an expression, through sculptural installation, of the Vietnam/American war and its contemporary relevance.

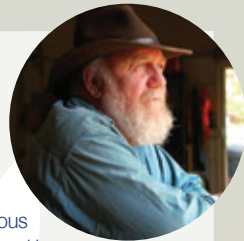

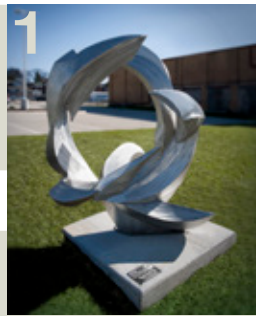

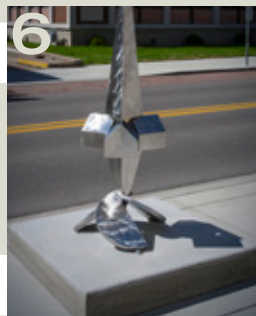
