

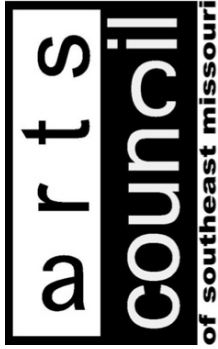

# Paint Cape Girardeau Plein Air Event

## CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY FEES

This event is open to individuals of all skill levels. Please see the definitions we have applied to each competition category in order to register at your appropriate skill level. Each quick paint and the long paint is open to all three categories. Participants will only be judged against those in their own category for these events. Special Paints are open to Intermediates and Professionals, but only a single overall winner will be chosen. Canvas sizes are at the discretion of the artist. Acceptable mediums include oil, acrylic, pastel, charcoal, pen, and pencil.

### Professional:

**Registration Cost \$50 or \$40 for Arts Council members**

This category includes individuals who consider themselves experienced artists, have placed in Plein Air events, have taught art, or feel that their experience level places them in a professional standing.

### Intermediate:

**Registration Cost \$25 or \$20 for Arts Council members**

This category includes individuals who have not previously placed in a juried Plein Air event, who do not make the majority of their income from painting sales, and who have not taught art.

### Beginner:

**Registration Cost \$10**

This category includes individuals who want to participate in our exciting annual event. We welcome all ages in this category, but all individuals under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

## EVENT DEFINITIONS

**Quick Paints:** Quick Paints 2 & 3 will challenge artists to paint the historic area of Cape Girardeau, while QP 1 will allow artists to choose any location within Cape Girardeau city limits. Four-hour painting blocks limit these paints.

**Long Paints:** Artists will choose any location within the historical downtown district of Cape Girardeau to paint. This painting may be worked on throughout the weekend, once the canvas has been checked in.

**Special Paints:** Sponsored by individuals and groups in the community who wish to have a particular location portrayed. These events will have single purchase award winners. More details on these events will be available soon.
