### Juror

**Cleda Curtis** was born in Clarksville, Arkansas but grew up in Oran, Missouri. She received a Bachelor of Arts degree in fine art from the University of the Ozarks in Clarksville, Arkansas and attended graduate school at Portland State University in Portland Oregon. Since then she has lived and traveled extensively in the US, Canada, Europe, Africa and the Middle East, where she has executed many commissioned portraits.

Whether working in oils, pastels or watercolors, Cleda creates her portraits in the realistic tradition, treating children with the same dignity as adults. Her procedure is the same when working with still life and floral paintings.

Through her studies in museums, universities and private workshops taught by the nation's leading artists, Cleda became a well-known coupled with her sensitivity to the needs of her students has made her a very popular and successful teacher. She teaches the basic principles of painting and drawing that artists have used for hundreds of years. As did the Old Masters, she believes in learning and passing it on.

In addition to teaching nationwide workshops, Cleda has become a popular speaker and juror among art organizations.

### Awards

## Schedule

- June 9** Exhibit Opening Reception 2PM at Southeast Hospital Meeting Room by Elevator C
- Aug 24** Exhibit Closes. Please pick-up exhibited art from 9 am to 12 pm in the Corridor between elevators A and C.
- Aug 27 – Aug 31** Alternative Days to Pick up pieces at Arts Council
- Sept 7** Shipped works ready for return

## Shipment and Delivery

Shipping artwork to and from the exhibit is the responsibility of the artist. Artist may use his/her own shipping company preference, and is responsible for scheduling delivery and pick-up of artwork. Works must be labeled with artist's name, title of work, media, and price. **Shipping cartons must be reusable and within shipping guidelines.** Please use professional grade boxes. No packing peanuts allowed. Late or damaged work will not be exhibited. Hand deliveries will be accepted during normal gallery hours, 10 am to 6 pm, from May 1<sup>st</sup> through May 11<sup>th</sup>.

## Return of Work

Exhibited, hand-delivered work **MUST** be picked up at the close of the exhibit, Saturday, August 24, between **9 am and 12 PM in the Corridor between Elevators A and C.** If you are not able to pick up your pieces on this day, the Arts Council will hold your pieces until August 31st, 2019. Shipped works will be crated and ready for shipment by Sept. 7. **It is the responsibility of the artist to provide postage and insurance to and from the exhibit and to schedule delivery and pick-up of the work.**

## Liability

Receipt of the completed form constitutes your agreement with all conditions established in the prospectus. Consent to reproduce works photographically, for publicity purposes, is assumed to be granted.

All reasonable care will be taken with your works, but the Arts Council of Southeast Missouri will not be responsible for theft or damage incurred at the location. We recommend artists provide their own insurance coverage for each submission.

## Statement of Purpose

Art for the Health of It provides a way to utilize art as a calming agent in a stress-laden environment, while demonstrating the health and healing benefits of artistic images and expression. The exhibit will be displayed in the Corridor between Elevators A and C at Southeast Hospital.

## Eligibility

Open to all area artists 18 years and older. Entries must be original, two-dimensional works in any medium, not previously exhibited at Southeast Hospital, or created in a workshop or class. Maximum size 48" x 48", including frame. Maximum weight: 75 lbs. Works must be framed and wired for installation. NO SAW TOOTH HANGERS. Nudes and unframed works will not be exhibited. The Juror reserves the right to disqualify any work not suitably presented, or that varies from the submitted image. Accepted works of art will remain on exhibit during the duration of the event unless otherwise allowed by the event Director. This is for both sold and unsold works during the event.

## Entry Fees

The non-refundable entry fee is \$35 for up to three works (Arts Council Members pay \$30) and \$5.00 for each additional entry after that. There is no maximum number of entries, but no more than three works by any artist will be exhibited. Diptychs and triptychs will be considered as two or three entries.

## Entry Procedure

Entries will be accepted in the form of a JPEG image on a CD, or online at [www.capearts.org](http://www.capearts.org). **You can email entries at: [director@capearts.org](mailto:director@capearts.org)**

High resolution images are preferred. **Required: 1 image per each 2-D piece.** We suggest 300 dpi at 4" x 6". Also include title, medium, size (indicated as height first, width second) on the attached form, and please label digital images as: **smith01\_title.**

**For Mailed Entries, Please Include:** Entry Fee (payable to Arts Council), completed entry form, CD, and self-addressed and stamped return envelope.
