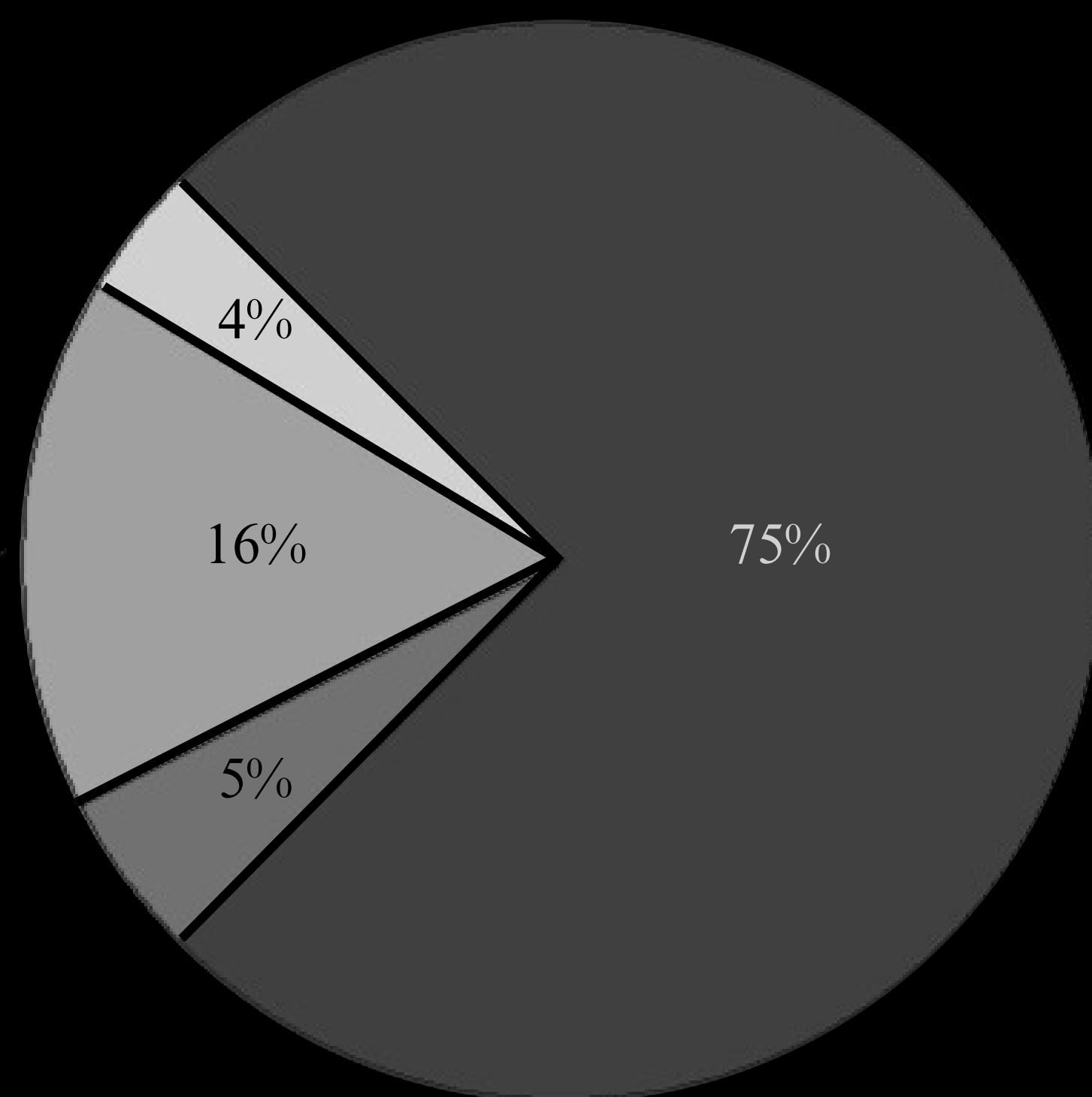


# EVERYONE BELONGS UNDER THE SUN

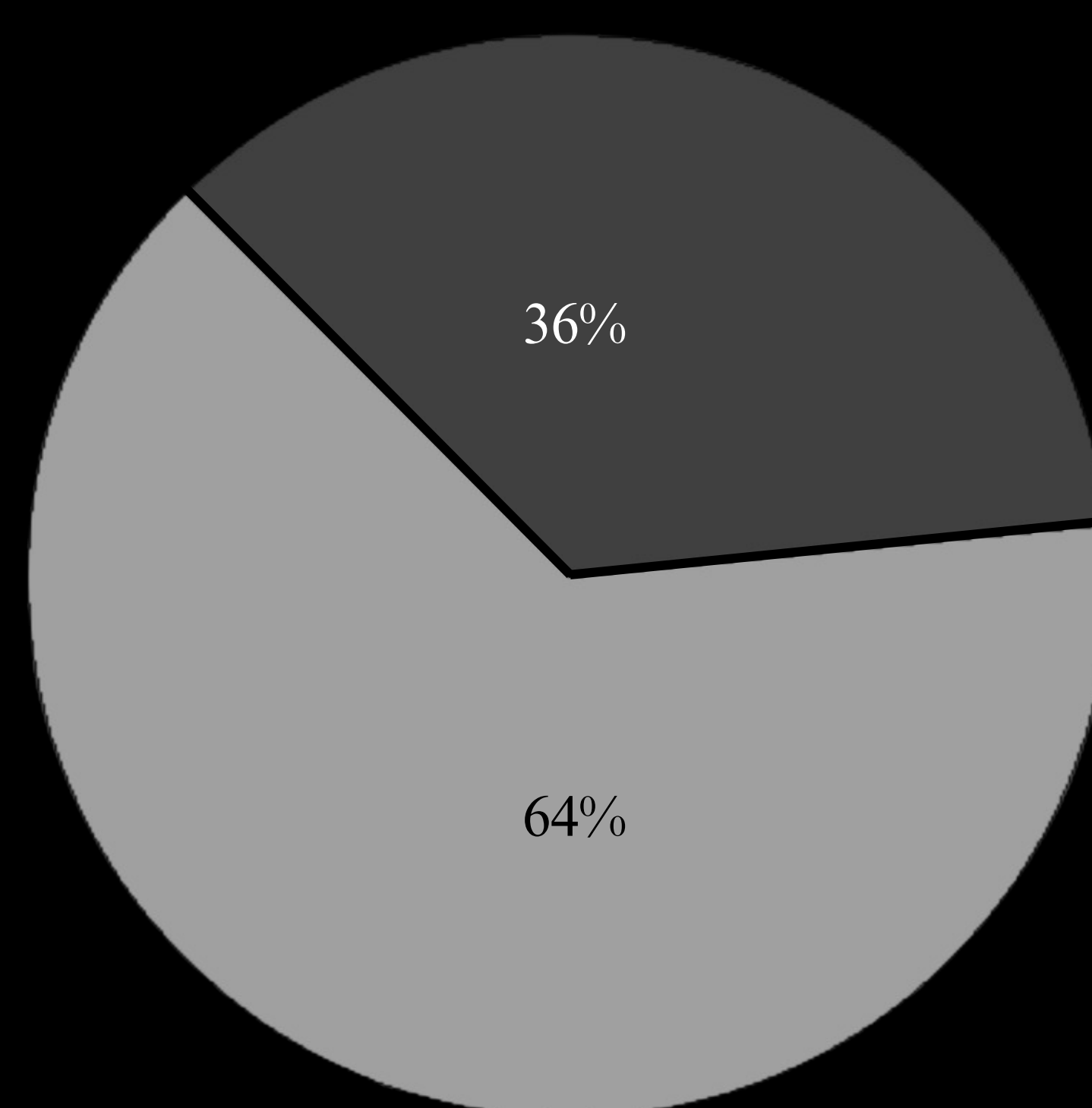
